# Shasta County

- Population <200,000 people
  - 26.2% of families with children under 5 are in poverty.
  - 60% of our births are Medicaid funded
- No nursing home visitation since 2003 through the health department
- Mother baby visits provided by the hospital stopped approximately 5 years later
- MIECHV funds established Shasta County NFP Team in April 2012

# Shasta County

- Co-locates direct service programs in Regional Offices
  - County Perinatal Drug and Alcohol Program – closing gap with perinatal treatment services
  - WIC – collaboration pilot project to engage hard to reach families
  - CalWORKs Behavior Health Teams
  - Community Health Advocates
  - Eligibility Services
  
- Coordination Advisory Board
  - Decision tree for medical providers
  - Case coordination and warm hand off with Shasta Head Start

# Shasta County

- Collaboration
  - Knowledge of Memorandum of Understandings (MOU's)/Agreements/Contracts
  
  - Utilizing already existing MOU/Agreements..
    - Cal-Learn
    - Shasta Head Start agreement
  
  - Referral resources
    - Healthy Babies Program (Funded by First 5 Shasta)
    - CareNet – provides points towards baby purchases in agency store
