


# Quality for California's Early Learning and Care Settings – From Silos to Systems

- A historic “big lift”


# Building on the Past to Leverage a New Vision

- Increase access to high-quality early learning settings


## **Workforce**

## **Systems**


- Support local quality improvement systems






# Expanding Access to Quality: Children Served by Setting Type
