- **Type:** Locally developed

- **Length:** One three-hour session (Session 1 only) or two three-hour sessions (Sessions 1 and 2)

Training Description:

Session 1: Participants will reflect on ways adults can promote the development of school readiness skills through relationships, interactions, and environment.

Session 2: Participants will reflect on experiences and interactions from session 1. They will work on skill-building to plan and promote community connections.

Training Methods: Lecture, handouts, demonstration and practice during training, written reflection, self or program assessment, and facilitated peer discussion
