



Classroom Assessment Scoring System[®] Calibration Sessions Fiscal Year 2015-16

First 5 California (F5CA) is offering online calibration sessions on each Classroom Assessment Scoring System[®] (CLASS[®]) tool between July 1, 2015, and June 30, 2016, as follows:

CLASS observers are encouraged to participate in at least one calibration session (approximately six-months after certification or recertification) for each tool on which they are certified. Calibration allows CLASS assessors to practice coding, receive immediate feedback, and further hone their observation and coding skills. Results show assessors who participate in calibration sessions between reliability tests are more likely to pass recertification and score higher when they do.

Calibration registrants will receive an e-mail directly from Teachstone[®] approximately two weeks before the testing window opens. The e-mail includes instructions on how to access the calibration video test and webinar. The registrant's CLASS certification must be current in order to participate in the calibration session.

F5CA receives a summary of calibration participants and their overall reliability score following each calibration session. F5CA does not receive details about individual participants and their scoring on individual dimensions. If a consortium is interested in the results for its assessors, please ask assessors to provide a copy of their score reports.
