
Refugee Family Support (RFS) funding:

 Commission Meeting
- Authorization: \$3 million for one year
 - Three RFS focus areas
 - Six Grantees
 - Implementation timeline

- Reach out to additional families
- Data collection and evaluation



From September 2022 to March 2023, the RFS grantees served:


395 families, including:



Demographics – by country of origin








Demographics – by home language

- 276 families

Emergency Housing



- 8 families
- 46 individuals
- 3 pregnant women
- 12 children

Other Services

- Provision of basic needs: 257 families
- Provision of healthcare/wellbeing: 243 families
- Language support services: 102 families
