First 5 California Positions on Bills and Public Policy

Sponsor	Develop legislative, budget, and/or regulatory proposal, background and language, and secure author; actively advocate for the passage of the proposal as a top priority as the proposal aligns with First 5 California's (F5CA) Young Children Policy Agendas, Mission Statement, North Star, and Audacious Goal. Actively advocate for the passage of the proposal.
Co-Sponsor	Work cooperatively with one or more organizations to develop legislative, budget, and/or regulatory proposal, background information, and secure author as the proposal aligns with F5CA's Young Children Policy Agendas, Mission Statement, North Star, and Audacious Goal. Actively advocate for the passage of the proposal.
Support	Actively pursue and advocate for passage of the policy proposal as it aligns with F5CA's Young Children Policy Agendas, Mission Statement, North Star, and Audacious Goal. Actively advocate for the passage of the proposal.
Support If Amended	Support only if appropriate amendments are adopted in a legislative, budget, and/or regulatory proposal as existing bill language does not align with F5CA's Young Children Policy Agendas, Mission Statement, North Star, and Audacious Goal.
Oppose	Actively pursue and advocate for the defeat of a legislative, budget, and/or regulatory proposal as it does not align with F5CA's Young Children Policy Agendas, Mission Statement, North Star, and Audacious Goal.
Oppose Unless Amended	Actively pursue and advocate for defeat of a legislative, budget, and/or regulatory proposal if it is not amended to address concerns as it does not align with F5CA's Young Children Policy Agendas, Mission Statement, North Star, and Audacious Goal.

Monitor Track legislative, budget, and/or regulatory proposal and any amendments to determine impact as the bill progresses through the legislative process. Should major changes occur that requires a formal position, bill will be reviewed by the Public Policy Advisory Committee and Executive Director.

Neutral/No Position Staff notes the existence of a legislative, budget, and/or regulatory proposal, but F5CA does not have a policy position on the topic, and no action is taken unless amendments change the status of the bill.
