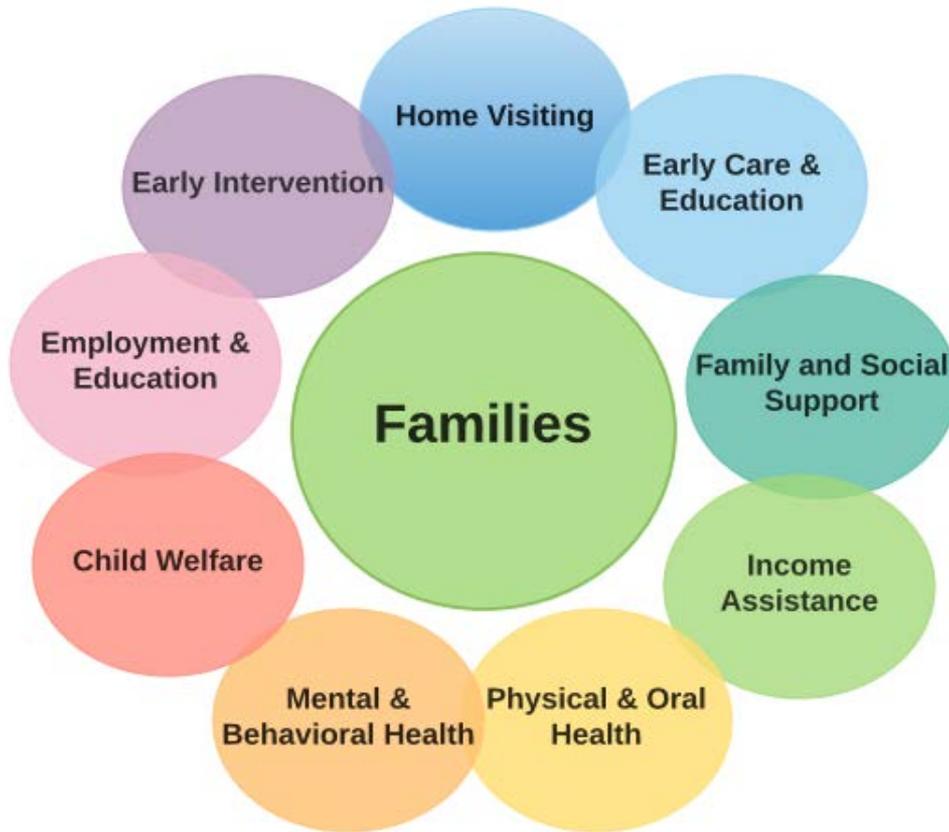

Help counties create a sustainable, unified system that supports families with the home visiting services they need and maximize available funding to serve more families.



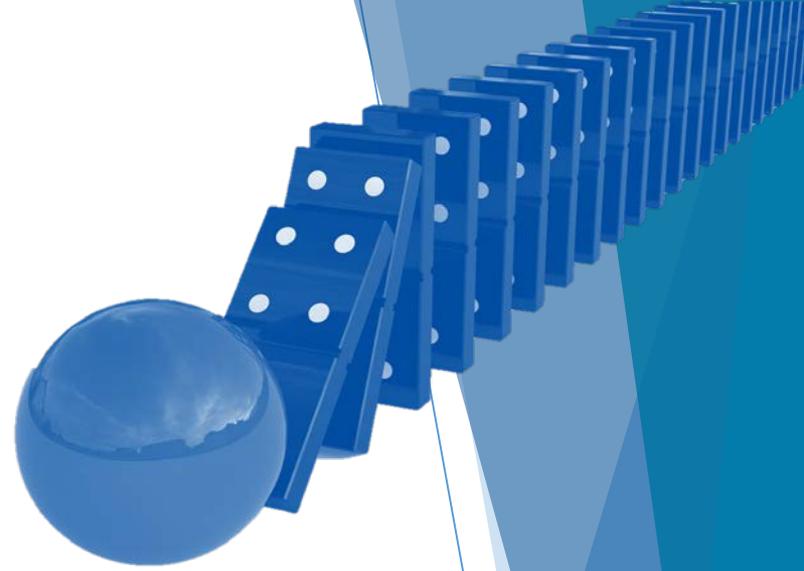
# HV is Part of Early Childhood System of Care



Coordinated network of comprehensive services and supports

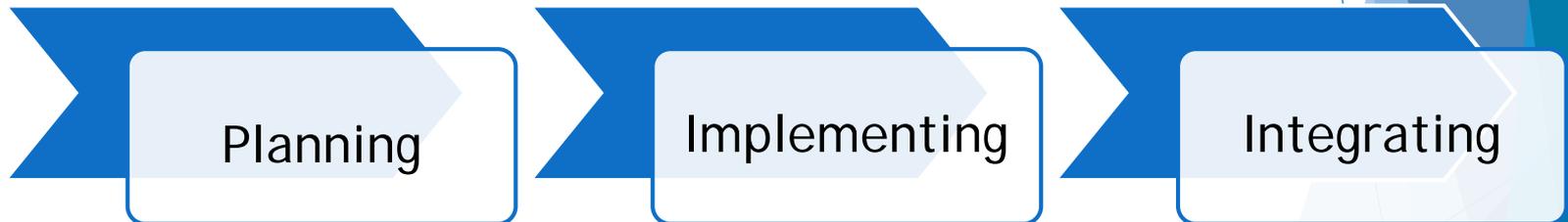


# Vision

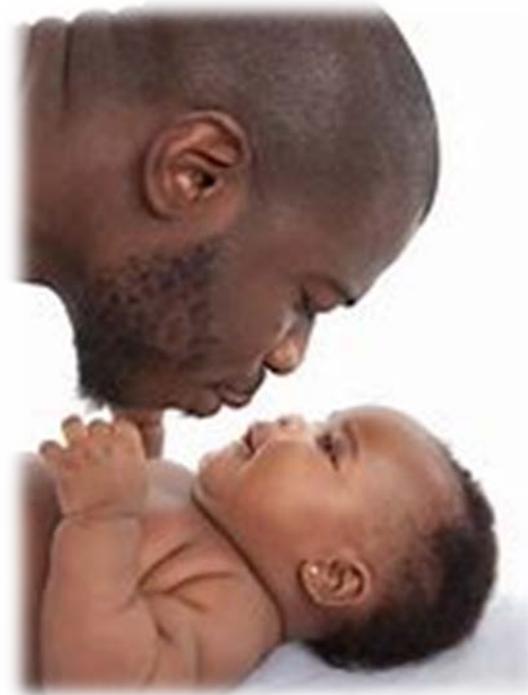
# Planning Funds



- ▶ Build a shared vision
- ▶ Conduct an environmental scan
- ▶ Select one or more evidence-based home visiting models
- ▶ Identify state (or other) funding
- ▶ \$100,000, no match requirement

# Implementation Funds

- ▶ Update environmental scan data
- ▶ Expand access
- ▶ Strengthen home visiting coordination
- ▶ \$200,000, 1:1 match requirement



# Integration Funds



- ▶ Strengthen coordination across home visiting programs
- ▶ Integrate home visiting into other systems
- ▶ \$200,000, 1:1 match required

# Other Data Requests

- ▶ Family enrollment, referrals, and linkages
- ▶ Other data for evaluation led by Home Visiting Applied Research Collaborative
- ▶ Child Trends Home Visiting Workforce Evaluation  
March 2020 – January 2022
  - ▶ May – June: Preliminary data collection to understand impact of COVID-19 on programs, staff, and families
  - ▶ Summer – Fall 2020: Workforce scan and higher education scan
  - ▶ Fall 2020 – Spring 2021: Supply and demand analysis and mapping

- How has the home visiting workforce adapted during COVID-19?
- What are the staffing issues programs are facing?
- What is the overall well-being of the home visiting workforce?
- What challenges are families facing adapting to virtual home visits?
- How has supply and demand changed in the context of COVID-19?
